Tournament Rules

- 1 Team Rosters and pick up player forms will be submitted on Friday of the Tournament, **to the Tournament Director before your first game and become official.** Failure to submit your roster could result in a game forfeit
- 2 Maximum of two (2) pick up players allowed per team
- 3 NO player is allowed to play on more than 1 (one) team in the Tournament
- 4 16/18u teams will have no more than four (4) 18u players, and 18u players cannot pitch.
- 5 ASA lineup rules apply. Teams will not bat their entire line up
- 6 Teams will have a 3 game guarantee scheduled
- 7 No Pool Play or Seeding - tournament brackets will begin on Team's first game
Be at the field at least 30 min early to warm up. Tournament Director or umpire will start games up to 15 min early if schedule allows.
- 8
- 9 **No new inning at 1:20 and DROP DEAD at 1:30 ON FRIDAY ONLY – Saturday/Sunday no drop dead**
- 10 No Game will end in a tie. USA Softball Tie Breaker Rule will be used. The player scheduled to bat last in the inning will be placed at 2nd.
- 10a IF A GAME IS TIED AT DROP DEAD TIME ON FRIDAY, the winner will be the team with lead at the bottom of last full inning.
- 11 Saturday and Sunday NO NEW inning after 1:20 no drop dead (strictly monitored, umpires will keep and announce official start time)
- 12 NO Time limit on the Championship or IF NEEDED games
- 13 ASA Run Rule in effect, 15 after 3, 12 after 4, 8 after 5, 1 after 7
- 14 All substitutions will come through the home plate umpire and be communicated to both dugouts.
- 15 Field ground rules will be explained at the pre-game conference.



Coaches, Player, Parent Expectations

As stated above, we the Staff of McCall Mountain Madness want to host a fun and complete summer tournament where players play hard, coach's coach strong and parents root their kids on.

Understanding that we put emphasis on the "fun" of this tournament, the Tournament Director(s) have expectation of Coaches, Players and families that must be adhered to at all times.

Tournament Directors and Umpires are committed to promoting a professional, well run Tournament.

If for any reason these expectations are unacceptable to your Team, we understand you looking for a different tournament to attend in place of ours.

Coaches-

- 1) Head Coaches have the right to communicate with umpires, but will do so in a professional, courteous and respectful manner.
- 2) All Coaches will not direct any negative communications to opposing players.
- 3) Head Coaches will communicate directly with Tournament Director(s) with any issues.

Players-

- 1) Players will leave communication with umpires to coaches.
- 2) Players will play hard, play to win, but win or lose will end the competition at the end of the game.
- 3) Players will cheer FOR their team and not AGAINST or taunt their opponents.

Parents-

- 1) Family members/friends will be content to let their kids compete and understand they are non-participating spectators of the games.
- 2) Family members/friends will root for their team and not root against their opponents.
- 3) Family members/friends will not direct any negative communications to opposing players, coaches or umpires.
- 4) Family members/friends will work through their Head Coach for any needs and not have direct communication with Tournament Directors or Umpires.

Umpires-

- 1) Will conduct themselves professionally at all times.
- 2) Will manage the game for the safety and sportsmanship of both teams.

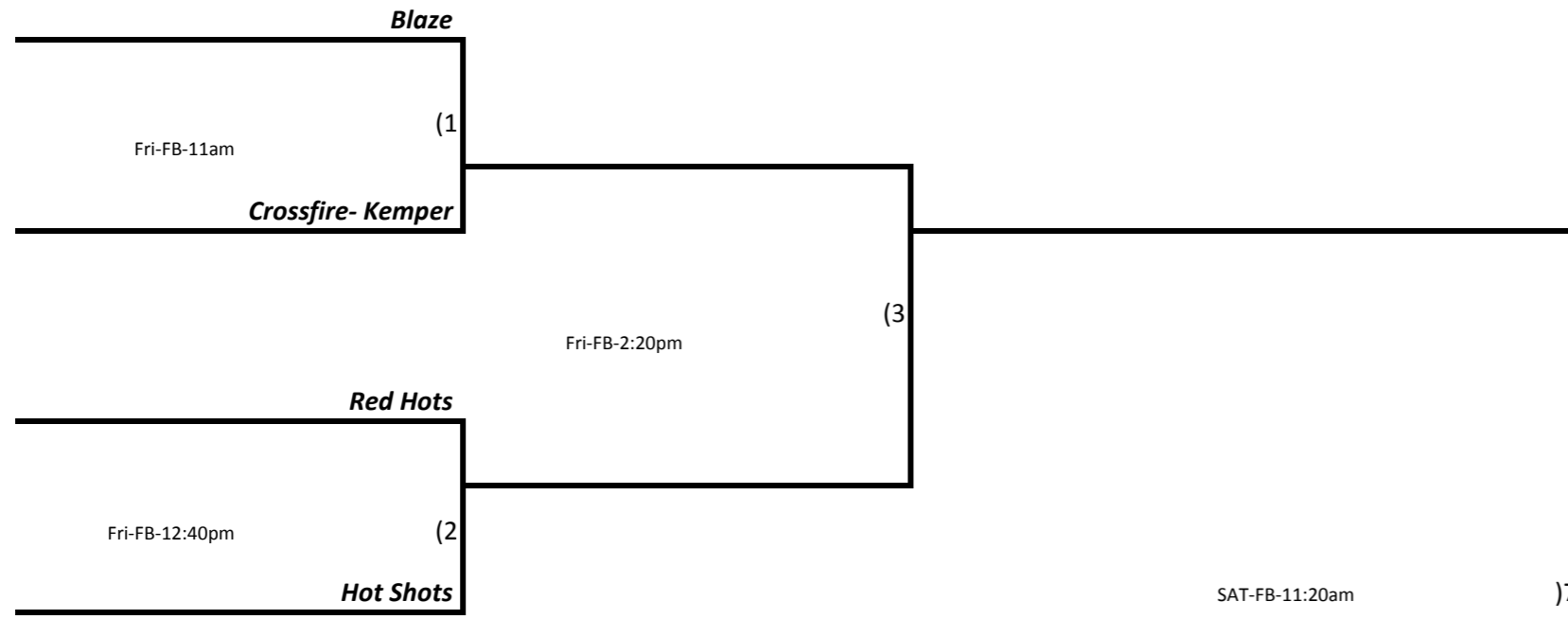
